Staff entering must be employed by Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust or work within a Health and Social Care setting in North Yorkshire. You can nominate yourself, a team or an individual.

Two categories, each with a cash prize of £100:

- **Category 1**
Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust IPC Champion Award 2016
(This entry is open to any member of staff employed by HDFT).
- **Category 2**
North Yorkshire and York Community IPC Champion Award 2016
(This entry is open to any person working in a Community Health and Social Care setting within North Yorkshire and York, e.g., General Practice, Care Homes, Domiciliary Care, Hospices).

Competition rules:

- Describe how you, a team or an individual have improved Infection Prevention and Control (250-300 words).
- Submit your entry via e-mail to ipccommunity@hdft.nhs.uk. It can be made in the body of the email or as a Microsoft Word attachment. Supporting photographs can be sent.
- Applicants nominating a team or an individual must seek their permission before applying.
- Deadline for submission is 30th September 2016.
- The winners will be notified by the end of October 2016.
- The winning entries will be showcased on the HDFT and Community IPC websites, IPC Advice Bulletins and social media.
